

2010 Census Underway

This month, Auburn citizens will begin receiving forms for the 2010 Census, conducted by the US Census Bureau. It is very important that these forms be completed and returned to the Census Bureau. Information collected during the census will determine how more than \$400 billion in federal funding will be allocated to projects such as schools, infrastructure, emergency services, hospitals, job training centers, and senior centers, just to name a few. Auburn citizens can do their part to ensure our community receives its share of this funding by taking a few moments to complete and return the census form.

Citizens who receive a form and have questions about completing it or would like assistance completing the form may visit one of the City's Questionnaire Assistance Centers (QACs). Each QAC has also been designated as a Be Counted (BC) site for citizens who do not receive



a census form in the mail, but wish to complete one. QACs and BCs are located at the following City facilities:

Make Your Presence Known... Bicyclists, joggers, and pedestrians reminded to wear reflective gear

Spring is just around the corner and with 34 miles of bicycle and multi-use paths and over 75 miles of sidewalk throughout Auburn, citizens will be hitting the streets and sidewalks to enjoy the change in weather. When you're out biking, jogging, or walking, don't forget to think safety first.

The law requires pedestrians and joggers to wear reflective material between the waist and shoulders on the front and back of clothing/outerwear for maximum visibility. Make sure motorists can see you from a distance of at least 500 feet by wearing re-



flective clothing between the hours of 30 minutes before sunset until 30 minutes before sunrise. Cyclists are required to have an operating headlight on the front of their bicycle and reflectors on the front and rear spokes of their wheels and pedals.

By working together, we can help make Auburn's roadways safer for cyclists, joggers, pedestrians, and motorists. For more information, please contact the City of Auburn Public Works Department at 501-3000.
