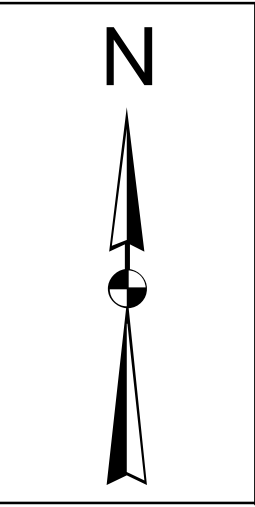
Definition of Watershed:
 Center for Watershed Protection - The area of land that drains to a particular point along a stream. Topography is the key element affecting this area of land. The boundary of a watershed is defined by the highest elevations surrounding a stream. A drop of water falling outside this boundary will drain into another watershed.
 Dictionary - A region or area bounded peripherally by a divide and draining ultimately to a particular watercourse or waterbody.
